

Building Blocks for RapidATO

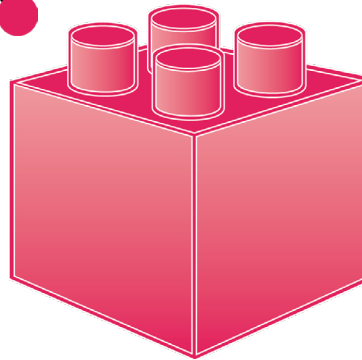
Following the three building blocks to a better and more rapid ATO (authorization to operate) allows:

- Information System Security Officers (ISSOs) to reuse compliance templates that eliminate duplicate and manual tasks in their security compliance planning
- Product teams to iteratively work on their ATO documentation and receive recommendations based on their system composition
- AI and data science to facilitate the recommendation of reusable narratives



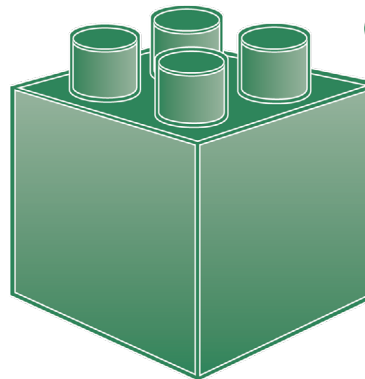
APPLY AI TO SECURITY DOCUMENTATION

Using AI and data science creates a reusable compliance library to support agency-wide compliance efforts by offering pre-sets, templates, and baselines for various IT systems.



DEVELOP A PUBLIC WEBSITE

A public site provides clarity on authorization and compliance. The public site must provide plain language information and create an entry point for users to understand the authorization process and available compliance tools.



DEVELOP A DIGITAL SERVICE BLUEPRINT

Blueprints allows users to reuse compliance data for a new system's ATO based on similarities with active compliant systems and prevents bad actors of data from fully understanding all the system's capabilities.
